Fourth Sunday of Lent March 6, 2016

Traditionally, the Fourth Sunday of Lent is called *Laetare Sunday* (**Rejoice Sunday**). Anticipating Easter joy, today's readings invite us to rejoice by being reconciled with God through repentance and the confession of our sins and by celebrating our coming home to be with our loving and forgiving God.

In the first reading, the Chosen People of God are portrayed as celebrating, for the first time in their own land, the feast of their freedom, by using wheat that had grown in the Promised Land.

In today's Responsorial Psalm, a rejoicing Psalmist invites us, "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord."

<u>In the second reading</u>, St. Paul invites the Corinthian Christian community to rejoice because Jesus has reconciled them with God by His suffering and death.

<u>Today's Gospel</u> celebrates the joy of the prodigal son on his "homecoming" to rediscover his father's forgiving and overflowing love. It is also the story of the rejoicing of a loving and forgiving father who celebrates the return of his prodigal son by

throwing a big party in his honor, a banquet celebrating the reconciliation of the son with his father, his family, his community and his God.

At the same time, by presenting a self-righteous elder brother, the parable invites us to avoid self-justification by imitating the repentant younger brother.

Let us admit the truth that we are an assembly of sinful people, ready to receive God's forgiveness and to experience Jesus' Personal Presence in the Holy Eucharist as a loving and forgiving God.
